# Program Information

- 16 Weeks of both Theory and Behind-the-Wheel Labs
  - 384 hours
  - 96 online hours of CDL Theory (completed via Blackboard LMS)
  - 288 face-to-face lab hours for skills and over-the-road driving
  - Students have the opportunity to test with a BCCC employed Third Party Examiner
- Students will be paired with one other student for a 2:1 student to instructor ratio for over-the-road (OTR) trips.
  - Students are expected to drive 750+ miles OTR, not including skills labs
- The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) requires all individuals that have never held a valid Class-A CDL Driver License to complete training through a registered entry-level driver training (ELDT) program.
  - Beaufort County Community College *is* registered as an ELDT approved training program.

# Registration Information

- Registration will open 30 days prior to the first day of class.
  - Outside factors such as Covid-19 and inclement weather may result in scheduled class dates being postponed or rescheduled.
- BCCC staff cannot hold seats in a class without valid registration. There are no exceptions.
- Make sure to ask about potential scholarships at registration.
- Registration Fee: \$241.25
  - BCCC Registration: \$180.00
  - BCCC Technology: \$5.00
  - BCCC Insurance: \$1.25
  - FMCSA Required Random Drug Testing: \$55.00

# The Registration Process

- Students must have the following documents to register.
  - Valid Class-A Commercial Driver License Permit
    - DMV Cost (subject to change): \$43.25
    - Free preparation tests can be found at [www.driving-tests.org](http://www.driving-tests.org) (public website)
    - DMV accepts walk-in with no appointment required
  - Valid DOT Medical Examination (Valid 1-2 years, see next slide)
  - Valid, Negative, DOT Drug Screen (no later than 30 days from sample submission to registration date, see next slide)
- In addition to the required documents, students must register with the Continuing Education registrar (Building 8). Students must bring the required documents to registration.

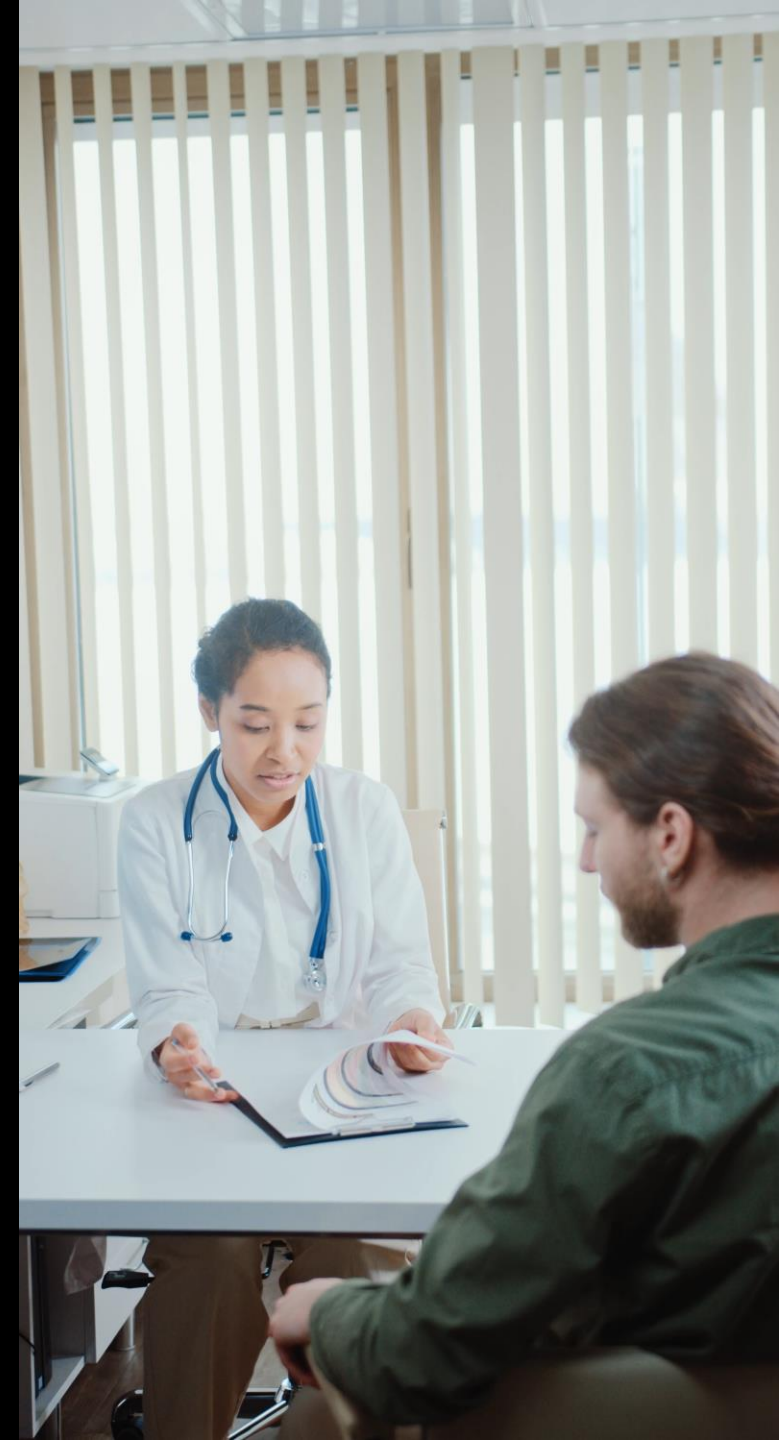

# Medical Documentation

- Prior to registration, students must have the medical documents below:
  - DOT Medical Examination
    - Valid for one to two years
  - DOT Drug Test
    - Within 30 days from the date of the drug test to registration
    - Must complete DOT Drug Test request through a state-approved medical office following the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration drug testing regulations.
