### **Census Date Procedure**

#### Curriculum

- 1. Calculate using 80 days for traditional 16 week courses.
- 2. Traditional course 10% dates will be calculated by colleague.
- 3. Hybrid and Internet course 10% dates is based on the number of days in the session or section. This is a manual entry in SRGD.

16 wk. classes =  $80 \text{ days} = 8^{th} \text{ day}$ 

14 wk. classes =  $70 \text{ days} = 7^{\text{th}} \text{ day}$ 

12 wk. classes = 60 days = 6th day

8 wk. classes =  $40 \text{ days} = 4^{th} \text{ day}$ 

4 wk. classes =  $20 \text{ days} = 2^{\text{nd}} \text{ day}$ 

- 4. Days are counted as Monday Friday, excluding holidays and breaks.
- 5. Traditional classes with no meeting days built (clinic, WBL) will be calculated on days in the course.
- 6. Traditional classes, labs and clinics are also calculated on the number of days in the course (cannot build meeting days for clinic meetings).

### **Continuing Education**

- 1. Regularly scheduled course (membership) 10% census dates will be calculated by colleague.
- 2. Non-regularly scheduled courses (contact hour) do not require a 10% census date to be calculated. These courses count hour for hour.
- 3. Hybrid and Internet course 10% census dates are manually calculated by the director/coordinator in collaboration with the course instructor; based on a determination of when 10% of the course content has been delivered. The 10% date is entered in SRGD when the director/coordinator builds the course section in colleague.
