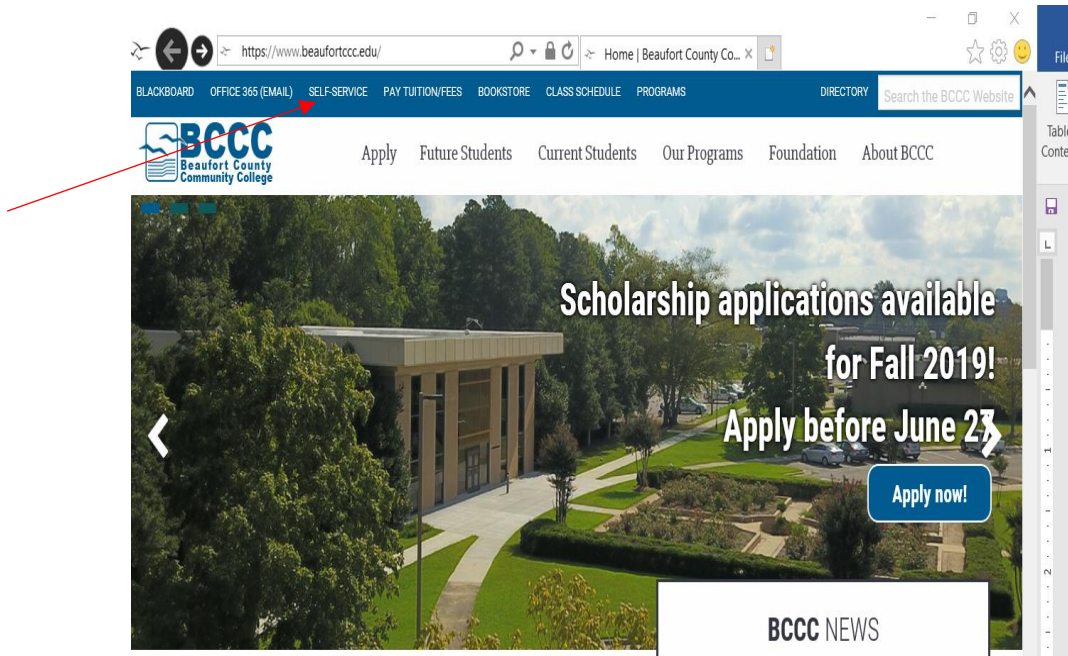
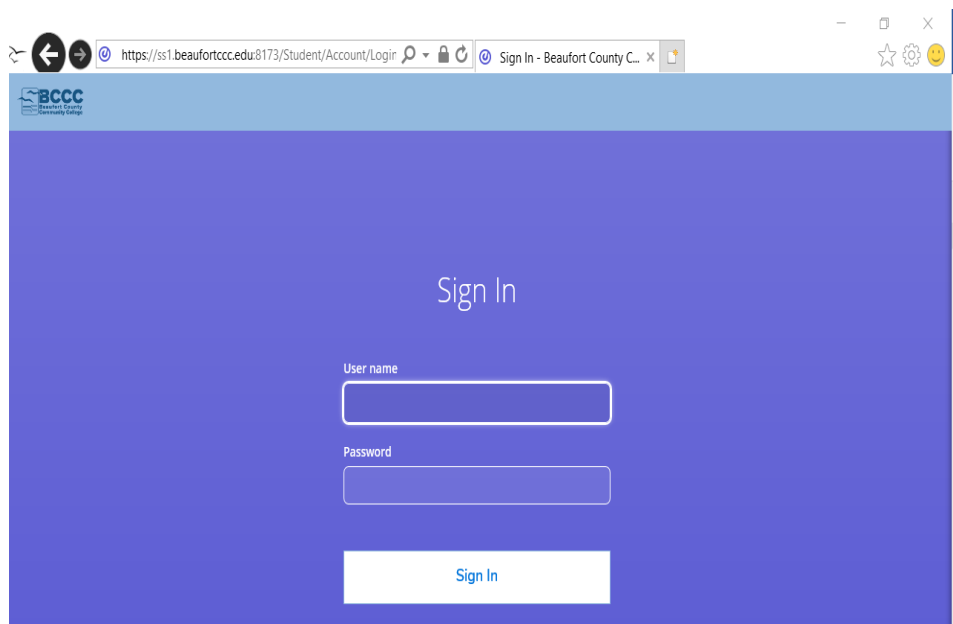


Financial Aid Self Service Functions

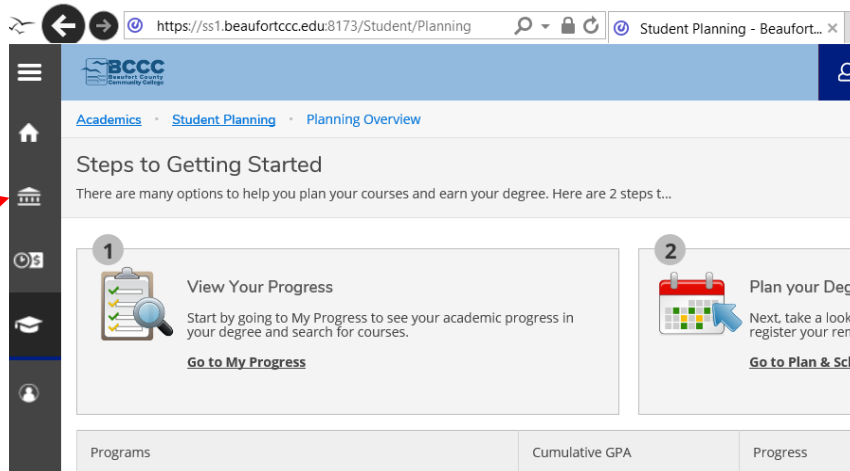
Students can access their financial aid information on-line: Self Service> Financial Information
Visit www.beaufortccc.edu , click on **Self Service**.



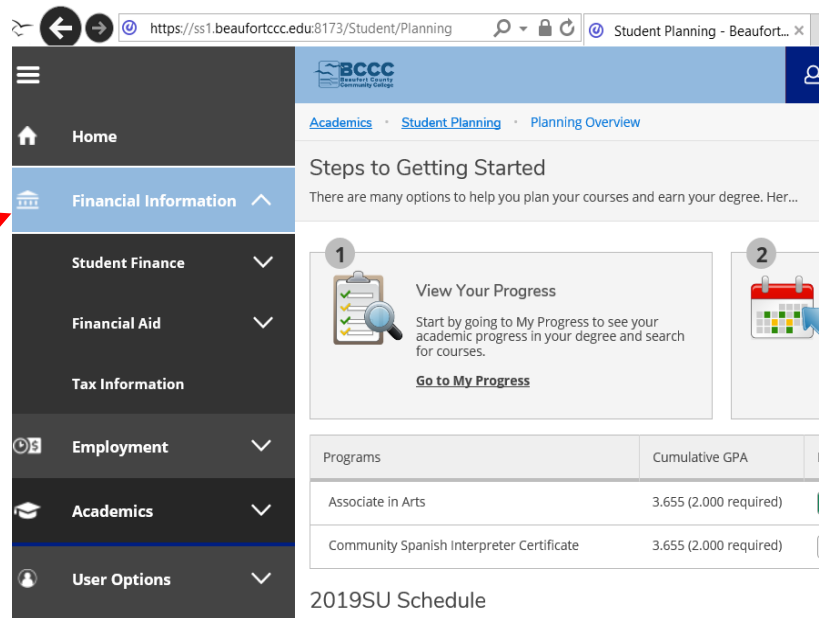
Sign In. Your username is your first name, middle initial and the last 4 digits of your BCCC student ID number. Your password is the last 6 digits of your Social Security number. This is the same information to use to access Blackboard, email, etc.



Click on the **Financial Information** symbol located on the left side of the screen.



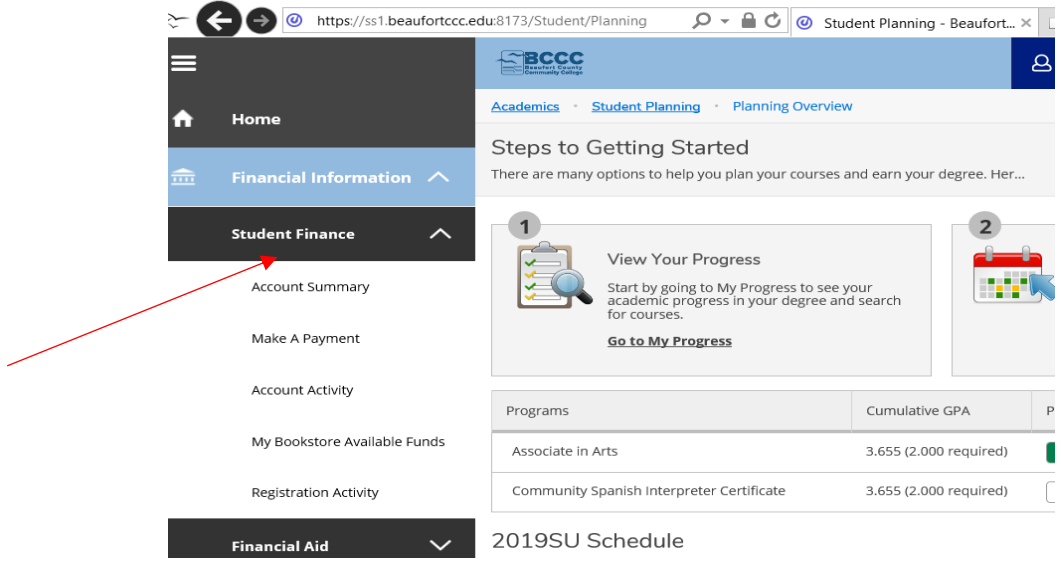
Click on the **Financial Information** tab to view **Menu options**.

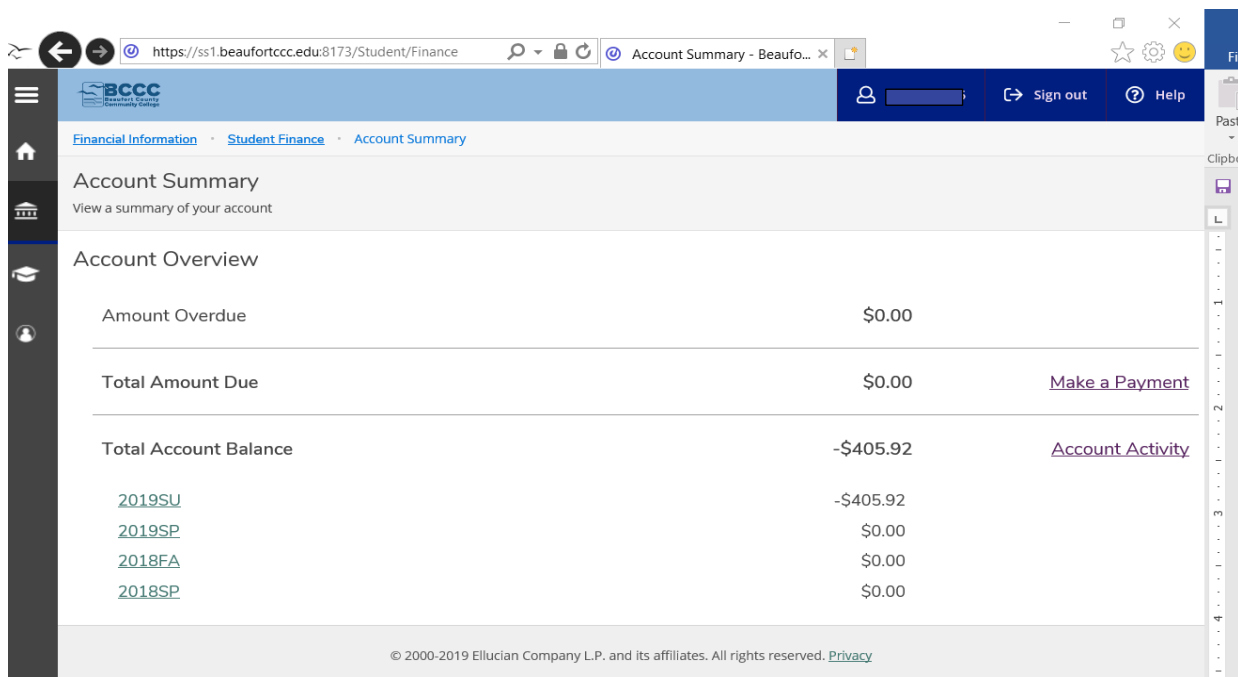

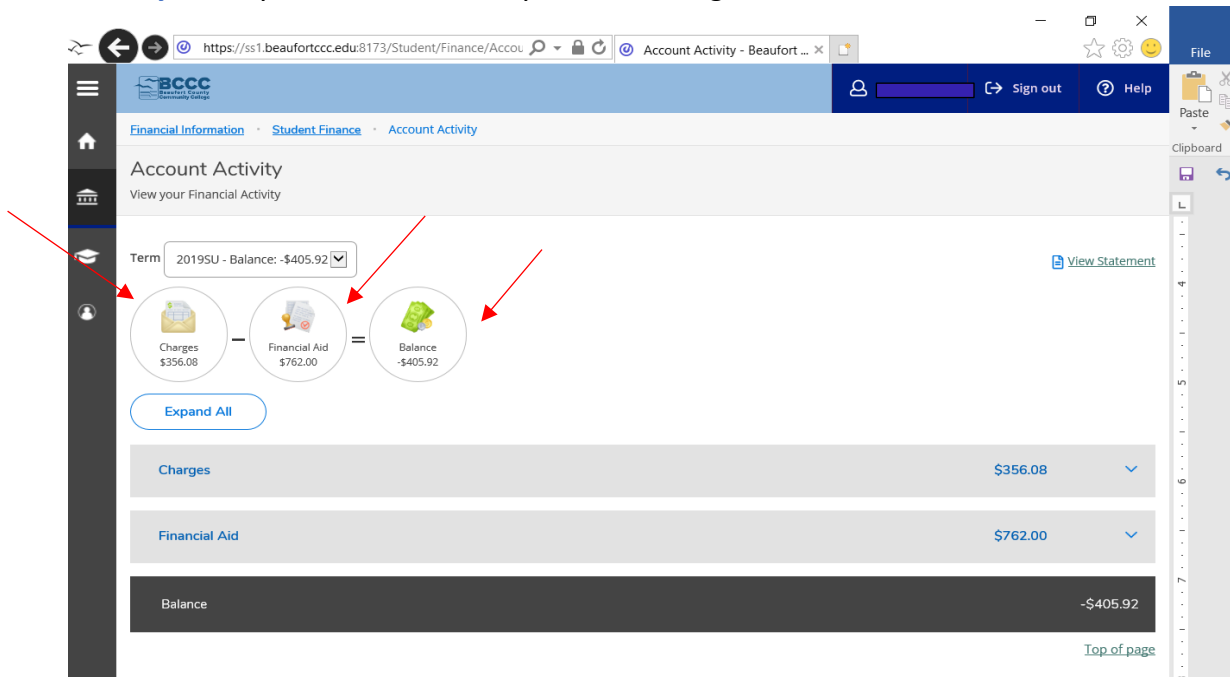


Menu Options Include:

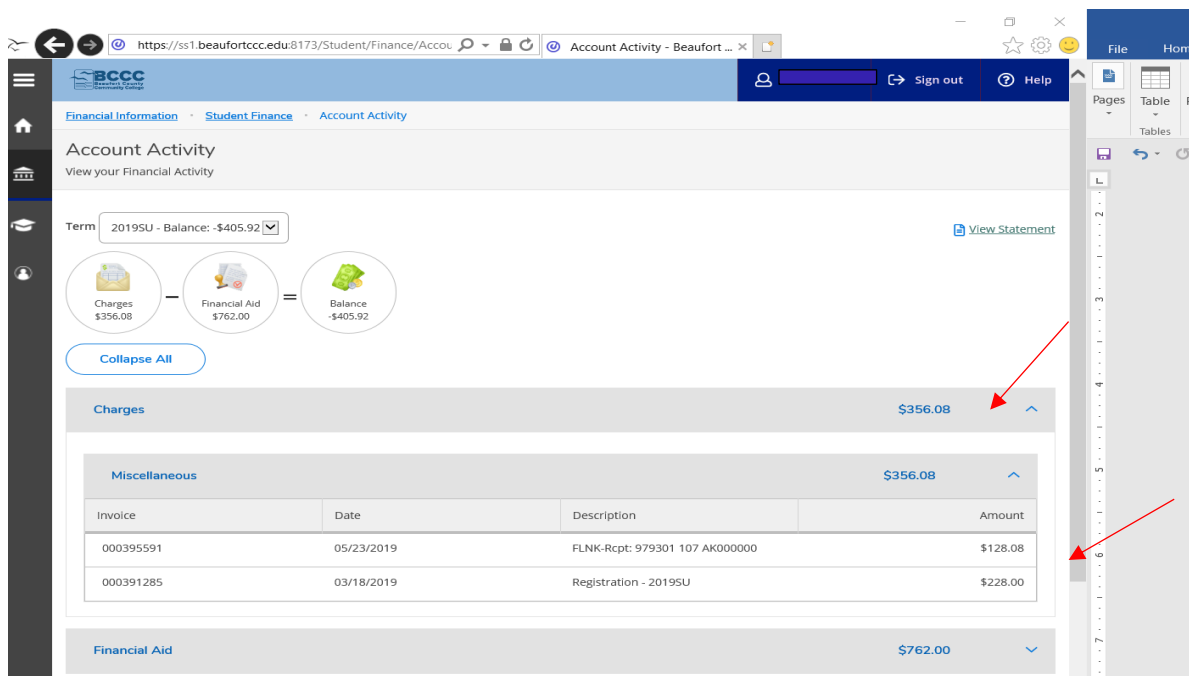
Account Summary: An overview of your student account by term. Click on term to view your financial aid information.



Account Activity: View your financial activity such as, charges, financial aid and balance.



Charges: Detailing on **Charges** under Account Activity, displays your Registration (tuition/fees) and bookstore charges. If you are awarded financial aid, your charges will be automatically deducted from your award total and the remaining balance will be issued to you by check. Checks will be mailed from the Business Office; students will be notified of the disbursement dates by email and the BCCC website.



Financial Aid Awarded

Detail on the **Financial Aid** tab to view amount awarded, disbursed or anticipated and currently ineligible amount. **Note:** a student's award amount may be greater than the amount disbursed. Award amounts are based on full-time status; each award fund will list the awarded amount based upon full-time enrollment. If the student is not full-time, the "Currently Ineligible" amount will be prorated based on enrollment status or courses outside of Program of Study. "Disbursed" is the amount disbursed/posted to the student account. "Anticipated" is the amount that is anticipated to post to the student account based upon enrollment status. "Comment" will list any additional information about your awards.

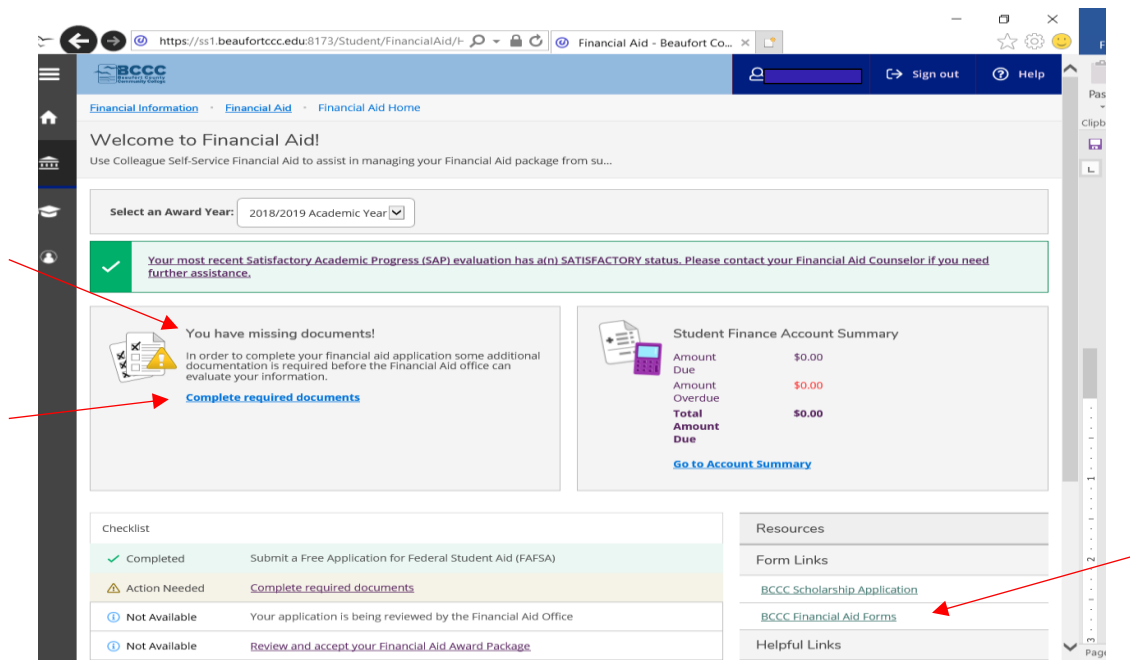

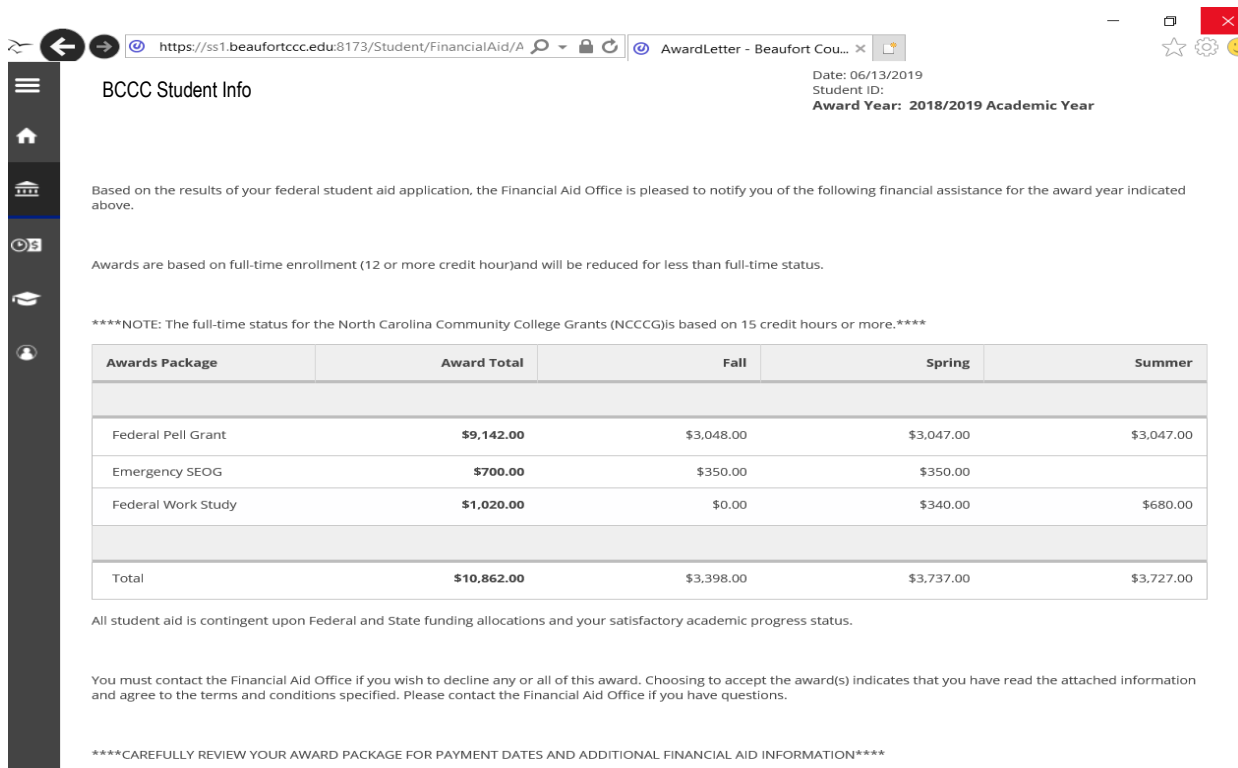

You must submit *all* documents and/or taken the necessary action requested before your file is complete and aid can be awarded. Documents must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office.





Award Letter: View your electronic award letter.

Award letters list the amount you qualified for during the academic year based on your EFC (expected family contribution). Generally, this amount is divided between fall and spring semesters. These award totals are based on full-time status. These totals will be reduced (prorated) if the student is enrolled less than full-time and will be reflected in your Self-Service **Account Activity**.



Federal Shopping Sheet: View your federal financial aid data.

The Federal Shopping Sheet or College Financing Plan is a consumer tool that institutions use to notify students about their financial aid package. A standardized form is designed to simplify the information that prospective students receive about costs and financial aid so they can easily compare institutions and make informed decisions about where to attend school.

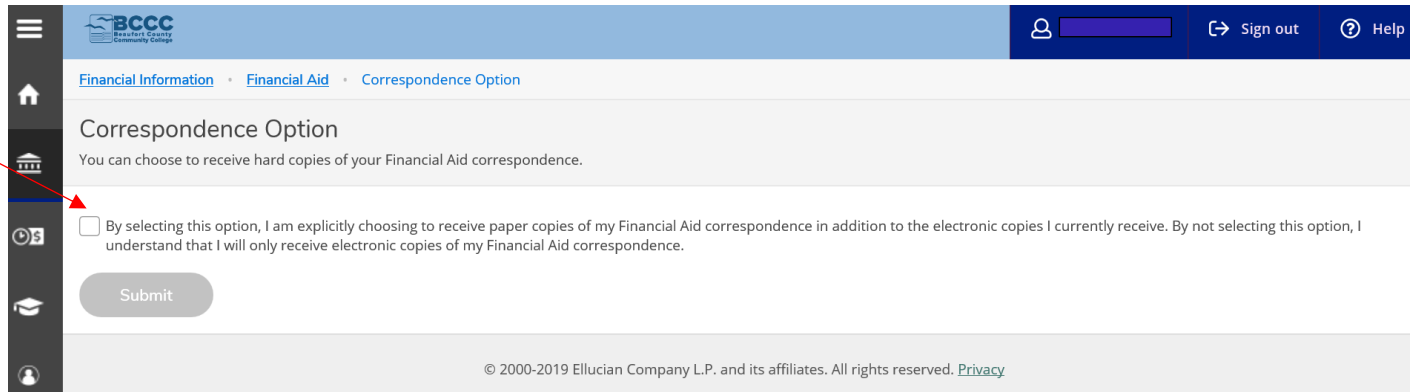

What does Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) mean? For a brief description of the minimum standards required, click on the arrow list below.

Academic progress is measured/calculated at the end of each term. Failure to maintain SAP can negatively affect your eligibility for federal and state aid. If your status is determined as "Unsatisfactory", you will not be eligible to receive aid. You may contact the Financial Aid office to discuss how to regain SAP and qualify for financial aid.
