

High School Transcripts:

Student copies, photocopies, and faxes of transcripts are not considered official.

College Transcripts:

Student copies, photocopies, and faxes of transcripts are not considered official. College transcripts must have regional accreditation to be considered for transcript credit evaluation.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS

International high school transcripts must be evaluated by the *American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (AACRAO), International Education Services, Credential Analysis Service*. If you have questions, please contact International Education Services at: 202-296-3359 or oies@aacrao.org. There is a fee for this service. The official copy of the evaluation must be mailed directly from AACRAO to the Admissions Office at Beaufort County Community College. Once the evaluation has been completed by AACRAO, Beaufort County Community College will interpret the report and make its own decision regarding admission.

High school transcript requirements will be waived for international students who have received the General Education Diploma (GED). Student copies, photocopies, and faxes of transcripts are not considered official.

College transcripts must have **regional accreditation** in order to receive transfer credit.
