Definition of Curriculum Credit Hours Policy

The College defines curriculum credit hours consistent with [1D SBCCC 400.1 Curriculum Definitions](#). Courses offered by the College are in accordance with definitions for the amount, level, and distribution of credit of the [Combined Course Library](#) of the North Carolina Community College System. Specifically, the College awards one semester hour of curriculum credit for each of the following:

- (1) 16 hours of classroom instruction
- (2) 48 hours of clinical practice
- (3) 32 hours of experiential laboratory work
- (4) 48 hours of faculty directed laboratory
- (5) 160 hours of work-based learning
