Accessibility Services Steps to Receiving Services

To receive accommodations while attending Beaufort County Community College, students must adhere to the following procedures:

- 1. Student completes an application for services. Application may be obtained from Coordinator of Accessibility Services.
- 2. The student must request accommodations (within a time frame that allows the college to make necessary adjustments).
- 3. The student must provide documentation of his or her specific disability when requesting accommodations.
- 4. Once appropriate documentation has been evaluated, the student and the Accessibility Services Coordinator will meet to determine what accommodations are necessary for equal access to programs and services on campus. **On average the evaluation process takes 7-10 business days.**
- 5. The Accessibility Services Coordinator, along with the student, will coordinate notification of the accommodation letters to the student's instructors each semester.
- 6. If requested by the student, the Accessibility Services Coordinator will be available for meetings with the student and his/her instructors.

Beaufort County Community College is committed to diversity, inclusion and ensuring equal access in all campus programs, activities and events to qualified individuals with disabilities.
