

Instructor Training

This 81 hour/credit course will provide the experienced criminal justice professional with the basic concepts of teaching adults, constructing audio visual aids, and developing written lesson plans. Upon successful completion of this course, the instructor candidate will be eligible to sit for the state certification exam. After successful completion of the exam, the instructor candidate will be allowed to apply for certification from the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education Training and Standards Commission (T&S) as a Probationary General Instructor.

Successful completion of the course of instruction will be based on the following:

- 100% Class Attendance
- Active Class Participation
- Development of a *Properly Constructed* Academic Checklist and 70 Minute Lesson Plan (Turabian and ISD Format)
- Development of a *Properly Constructed* Written Test that Corresponds with the Developed Lesson Plan
- Construction of Appropriate Teaching Aids for Course Delivery
- In Accordance to the Presentation Matrix Provided, Successfully Present, in a Classroom Setting the Prepared 70 Minute Lesson Plan
- Obtaining a 75% Passing Score of the Course Post-test Administer During the Course.

The number of participants for this, and all, Instructor Training Programs is limited to 18 participants per course by T&S. There is a prerequisite of four (4) years of criminal justice experience to apply for attendance. In addition, there is a written assignment which must be completed prior to full acceptance into the program. This assignment will be sent by e-mail after the initial application has been received and approved.
