

## NC Problem Gambling Grant Contest

The Problem Gambling program was established to provide and support effective problem gambling prevention, education, and outreach. BCCC is sponsoring a t-shirt design contest to help students in these areas.

### **T-Shirt Design Contest Prizes:**

**1<sup>st</sup> place** – This design will be featured on the official Beaufort County Community College Problem Gambling Prevention t-shirt and the designer will receive a \$125.00 bookstore credit.

**2<sup>nd</sup> place** - This design will be used to help market the Problem Gambling program's hotline number as an alternate. The designer will also receive a \$75.00 bookstore credit.

**3<sup>rd</sup> place** - The designer will receive a \$50.00 bookstore credit.

**Deadline: Wednesday, February 22, 2023 by 5:30pm**  
**Winners will be announced on or before February 24, 2023**

### **T-Shirt Contest Rules & Guidelines:**

1. Design will appear on the front of the shirt, and may not exceed 11" wide by 12" high.
2. Only one design per participant may be submitted.
3. The design must include a reference to prevent or educate and provide awareness of problem gambling.
4. Your design must be entirely original. By submitting a design you are guaranteeing that you hold rights to everything contained in your design, and that it does not contain any copyrighted material.
5. It is best if you create your design in Photoshop or Illustrator or another professional design program. Submit entries as medium resolution JPEG, PNG, or PDF files. Please be prepared to submit the original Illustrator or Adobe Photoshop file in the case your artwork is chosen. Design must be easy to reproduce by silkscreen. The college reserves the right to edit the winning design. Limit of 3 colors in the design.
6. Entries must be submitted to [Sheri.Powell@beaufortccc.edu](mailto:Sheri.Powell@beaufortccc.edu) by the contest deadline and have the subject line "T-shirt Design Contest."
7. Also contained in the body of your email submission must be your name, address, telephone number, and age (if under 15).
