

Table 1: High School Performance Benchmarks**Primary Placement**

The primary tool for placement in English and math is a student's unweighted high school GPA. In cases where a student does not have a GPA on file, we can use other measures of high school performance such as HiSet and GED scores on the most recent versions of those tests.

Gateways = 2.800+

Students who have an unweighted high school GPA of ≥ 2.800 can enroll in ENG-111 and MAT-121, MAT-143, MAT-152, and/or MAT-171

Requisites = 2.799 or less

Students who have an unweighted high school GPA of ≤ 2.799 must enroll in ENG-111 and ENG-045, and MAT-025 or MAT-035.

For Alternative Placement In cases where a student does not have a GPA on file and has not completed previous coursework in English or math, we can use test scores to place them into gateway English and math with or without requisites.					
Accuplacer Next Gen BCCC uses this placement test for both English and math. The English test has two parts, (1) reading and (2) writing. Students must take both. The math placement test is divided into subject areas. Students need only take the placement test that is aligned with their desired gateway math course.
